Muban Chombueng Rajabhat University promotes and supports SDG 13: Climate Action by organizing knowledge-sharing projects for students and staff, which include the following initiatives:

1. Project to Enhance Knowledge and Implement Net Zero Carbon Management

The project aims to enhance knowledge and promote the implementation of Net Zero Carbon Management within the organization, focusing on achieving carbon neutrality. The project will consist of the following activities:

- 1. Carbon Neutrality Awareness Session: On August 1, 2024, an educational session will be held to raise awareness about carbon neutrality, providing participants with knowledge on how to reduce carbon footprints and the importance of achieving net-zero carbon emissions.
- 2. Plant Survey and Carbon Absorption Study: On August 4, 11, and 12, 2024, the project will conduct a survey on plant species and their capacity to absorb carbon. This activity will take place in a designated pilot area, helping to assess how plant life can contribute to carbon sequestration and support the campus's carbon reduction efforts.



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3. Workshop on Net Zero Carbon Organization Management: On August 28, 2024, a hands-on workshop will be held at the Center for Science and Applied Sciences. This workshop will share practical knowledge and strategies for managing organizations aiming for net-zero carbon emissions. The goal is to equip staff, faculty, and students with the tools to effectively contribute to the university's environmental sustainability goals.

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2. Living Lab Project: Food Security and Environmental Management Workshop
