## Promotion of Love and Unity for Local Community Strengthening

Muban Chombueng Rajabhat University is working towards SDG 16: Peace, Justice, and Strong Institutions by strengthening the university as a safe and robust institution. It has implemented anti-corruption policies, conducted student or administrative representative elections, and regularly publishes financial information in the university's annual report.

### 1. Safety To School Project

The Faculty of Industrial Technology is organizing the Safety To School project to enhance safety knowledge and skills for both teachers and students in small schools under the Office of Basic Education Commission (OBEC) in Ratchaburi Province. This project focuses on safety education, occupational health, and environmental safety within schools, with a particular emphasis on fire safety and emergency evacuation drills. The goal is to equip participants with essential safety skills that they can apply in their daily lives, in their teaching, and in maintaining a safe learning environment.





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### 2. Project to Develop Teacher Competency in Small Schools to Address School Violence

The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences is organizing this project to develop the competencies of teachers in small schools in order to effectively address and prevent violence within the school environment. The project will focus on training teachers to understand the various forms of violence, its causes, and equip them with the necessary competencies to manage and resolve violent situations. Through activities such as lesson reflections, teachers will gain a deeper understanding of how to respond to and mitigate school violence, ensuring a safer and more supportive learning environment. The project is aimed at teachers in small schools across Ratchaburi Province.





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### 3. Community Learning Center Project to Strengthen Unity, Love, and Participatory Community Resource Management in Rang Bua Subdistrict, Chom Bueng District, Ratchaburi Province (Phase 1)

The Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences organizes this project to strengthen love, unity, and participatory community resource management in Rang Bua Subdistrict, Chom Bueng District, Ratchaburi Province. The project is conducted through a series of five training workshops:

1. **Data Collection and Knowledge Management for Community Resources:** Gathering information and knowledge to help manage local resources effectively.
2. **Training on Thai Yuan and Thai Song Dam Ethnic Knowledge:** Providing knowledge of Thai Yuan and Thai Song Dam cultures for integration into teaching and learning processes.
3. **Developing Community Resource Management Guidelines:** Creating a strategy for developing local community resource management capabilities.
4. **Development of Community Souvenirs:** Developing traditional souvenirs, such as "Tuk Tuk Balm," reflecting the identity of the Thai Yuan culture to elevate the community learning center.
5. **Strengthening Community Unity:** Building a sense of strength, love, and unity in the local community of Rang Bua Subdistrict to ensure the sustainable development of the area.

These activities aim to enhance local capacity and foster a sense of belonging and cooperation among community members for sustainable resource management and cultural preservation.





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## 4. Exhibition on Education and Right Livelihood

The Department of Local Development and Academic Services organizes this exhibition to disseminate the university's achievements to various agencies and educational institutions, facilitating learning and promoting a model for teaching that encourages ethics and professionalism in vocational conduct. This initiative aims to foster honesty, integrity, and the use of local knowledge and resources as the foundation for sustainable livelihoods in communities.

Through this exhibition, participants can explore innovative ways to improve local education, promote ethical career practices, and apply community-based resources for sustainable development.





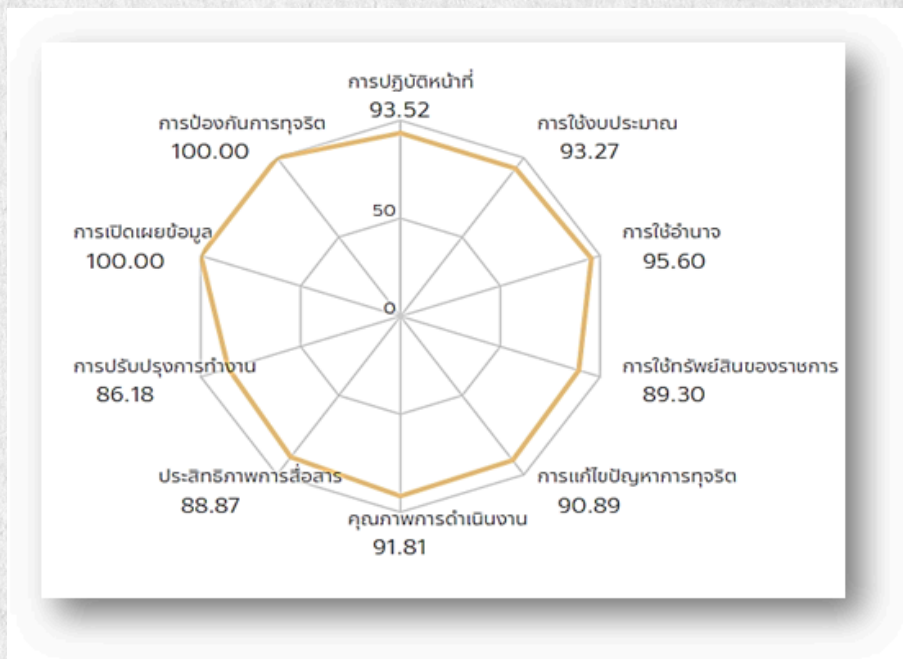
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## 5. Evaluation of Ethics and Transparency in the Operations of Government Agencies

### Integrity and Transparency Assessment (ITA) Results for the Fiscal Year 2024

In the fiscal year 2024, the university underwent the Integrity and Transparency Assessment (ITA) of government agency operations, achieving an overall score of 94.40 points. The scores for each individual indicator are as follows:

1. Performance of Duties: 93.52 points
2. Use of Budget: 93.27 points
3. Exercise of Authority: 95.60 points
4. Use of Government Property: 89.30 points
5. Corruption Mitigation: 90.89 points
6. Operational Quality: 91.81 points
7. Communication Efficiency: 88.87 points
8. Work Improvement: 86.18 points
9. Disclosure of Information: 100.00 points
10. Corruption Prevention: 100.00 points
