On January 5, 2023, Muban Chombueng Rajabhat University joined forces with the Social Value Assessment Association of Thailand to sign an MOU for the Social Value Accelerator Programme, aimed at promoting and developing social value assessment. This collaboration emphasizes the importance of measuring social impact, with a particular focus on the 37th Chombueng Marathon and its alignment with social impact (IMPACT). Key Objectives of the MOU:

- 2. Integration of Social Value Principles: To foster the development and integration of Social Value Principles within the university and related organizations.

- 4. Reflection of Social Return: To ensure that social returns are reflected in the planning and execution of projects, particularly focusing on the Chombueng Marathon as an example of community-driven impact.

On March 8, 2024, Muban Chombueng Rajabhat University and Ratchaburi Municipality signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the development of a continuing education program linking the curriculum with Tesaban School 1 (Wat Sattanarat Pirawat). The collaboration spans over a 4-year academic period, and in Semester 1 of the 2024 academic year, faculty members from Muban Chombueng Rajabhat University began organizing teaching and learning activities for Grade 1 students in secondary school.

It provides a platform for university faculty to engage in curriculum development and teach various subjects, aligning educational efforts for the community's benefit.
